MEMORANDUM FOR 12th Combat Aviation Brigade (CAB) Military Personnel

SUBJECT: 12th CAB Command Policy Letter 15, Alcohol Restriction for Newly Arrived Personnel Under 21 Years of Age

1. As our Army continues to battle sexual assault and harassment within our formations, it identifies patterns of behavior resulting in these incidents. One consistent factor in sexual assault and harassment incidences is the use and abuse of alcohol. Furthermore, the most at-risk population for sexual assault and sexual harassment are young Soldiers who have been in a new unit for less than ninety days. Temporarily restricting the consumption of alcohol by this vulnerable population is necessary to safeguard and promote the morale, discipline, and usefulness of members of the command and to maintain good order in the service.
2. Effective immediately, all first-term Soldiers under the age of twenty-one years are not authorized to consume alcohol, on or off post, within the first ninety days of their arrival to the Brigade.
3. This policy letter constitutes a lawful general order issued by the Commander, 12th Combat Aviation Brigade. Violations of this policy may result in punitive actions under the Uniform Code of Military Justice and adverse administrative action.
